

GETTING A JOB AT CAMP MEETING 2025

Thank you for your interest in assisting the South Atlantic Conference in serving our constituents during the 2025 Camp Meeting in Orangeburg, SC, June 9-14. Our theme this year is "Pentecost 25 – Restore, Renew, Revive."

Keep in mind that Camp Meeting is a spiritual gathering. We discourage anyone who may come only for a job and encourage all who come to attend the meetings and events planned for your age group.

As you seek to acquire a position of employment during Camp Meeting, keep in mind that hiring is based on a need for workers. Also, anyone 20 years of age and younger must provide proof of housing information during their stay in Orangeburg and present a picture ID upon arrival. (14-17-year-olds may use a school ID card).

Read through the following information to make this process as smooth as possible:

As you seek employment, take note of the following age restrictions:

1. The minimum age to work in most departments is 14 years old
 2. The minimum age for the Sabbath School Department is 18 years old
 3. The minimum age for the Security Department is 21 years old
 4. You must complete a background check through the Sterling Volunteers portal if you are 18 years old and older.
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1. If you know the department you wish to serve, contact the leader to determine if there are any jobs available.
 2. Complete the Online Application. **If you were employed during the 2023 and/or 2024 Camp Meetings, you do not need to complete another application.**

Go to www.sacjobinfo.com to complete the application. You may use a computer, tablet, or smartphone.

3. **Anyone 18 years of age and older by June 1, 2025**, must complete a mandatory background check (17 years of age and younger do not have to do this step). If you completed a background check between 2023-2025 you do not need to complete another one. Begin that process right away through the Sterling Volunteers portal by visiting www.ncsrisk/adventist. There is a course that must be completed first which takes about 45 minutes. On the home page choose FIRST TIME REGISTRANT. After logging in:

Select your Organization: **Seventh-day Adventist Church**

Select your State: *Either* **Georgia, North Carolina, or South Carolina**

Select your Conference: **South Atlantic Conference**

Choose the Role: **Camp Meeting Worker**

If you have already completed the background check because of a church office position between 2022-2024, you can skip this step.

4. You will need to complete a W-9 form once you receive a Clearance Letter when you arrive in Orangeburg in the Human Resource (HR) office. Come to the registration desk in the Adult Pavilion to get directions to the location of the HR office.

Once you are cleared through the background check (If you are 18 and older), completed the Online Application, and signed your W9, you will be given a Clearance Letter to present to a department supervisor.
