

Henry Monroe Wright

astor Wright served as a Minister, Professor, Church Administrator, Family Counselor, and Radio and TV host. Elder Henry Monroe Wright began his ministerial career in 1964. He has a Bachelor of Arts degree, two Master of Divinity degrees, and Doctor of Ministry studies at Vanderbilt University.

In his pastoral years, he has received over fifty awards and recognitions for pastoral leadership, preaching, and evangelism.

His years as a professor of religion were at Oakwood University from 1978-1983.

From 1995-2010, he served as an adjunct professor in Homiletics and Christian Ministry at Washington Adventist University.

Administratively, he has served as President of the Allegheny West Conference, as Executive Secretary of the Columbia Union Conference, and as Director of Education for Home Health, Inc.

During his career, Elder Wright has been given special assignments to serve on various committees, including the Adventist Media Center Reorganization Commission, General Conference Commission on Women's Ordination, the North American Division Committee for Union and Local Conference Secretaries' and Church Clerk Manuals, and the General Conference restructuring Committee in 1992. He founded the "Yours for the Asking" telecast in Columbus,

OH, which aired on WCMH-TV from 1974-1978. He has also written numerous articles in various church periodicals. Pastor Wright has had the consistent opportunity to be the guest speaker and evangelist at many events, both in the United States and throughout the world.

While being blessed in all of the above, Elder Wright was married to Carol Lindsey Wright (deceased) for 55 years. They were gifted with three sons, Henry Monroe Wright II, Harold Michael Wright (deceased), and Herbert Marcel Wright. The Wrights also have four grandchildren.

In December of 2017, Pastor Wright retired from full-time ministry. He thanks God for trusting him with over 53 years of full-time ministry!

His military career included five deployments in service to the nation, providing spiritual support and resilience training to service members.

Pastor Newbill pursued his call to ministry at Oakwood University, where he graduated in 2020 with a Bachelor's degree in Ministerial Theology and a minor in Psychology. While attending Oakwood he received the Student Service Leadership Presidential Award for his outstanding impact on campus. His leadership roles included Senior Class Chaplain, Oakwood University Chapel Director, School of Religion &




